- (三) 推動國民外交機會，增進國際社會對我國文化及童軍運動之瞭解。
- (四) 培養童軍青年國際合作與領導能力，以實踐童軍運動精神。
- (五) 培育 2029 第 17 次世界羅浮大會幹部。

### 四、活動地點：日本童軍總會那須野營場，CAMP NASU（日本栃木縣）

# **NIPPON ROVER MOOT 2024**

## **Outline**

### **Aim:**

To provide an opportunity for participants to develop the spirit and physical strength to serve society and to achieve self-realization in the future through spending time with their peers outdoors and participating in the program.

### **Objectives:**

- Provide an opportunity to deepen one's understanding about their own and to think about one's future.
- Provide an opportunity to deepen one's understanding of the culture and history of the host community and engage with the community directly.
- Enable to exchange opinions on issues that affect the participants and the society in which they belong.
- Provide an opportunity for participants to develop their creativity, initiative, and leadership skills.
- Respect the diversity of participants and take into account different needs.
- Invite Scouts from other NSOs and encourage international exchanges.
- Provide entertainment and recreation.

### **Theme:**

***"momentum"***

It means Influential, Vigorous, and Impetus.

Unstoppable impulse, Great enthusiasm, Excitement.

We chose this theme as full of energy that Rover Scouts hold innerly and as an opportunity to encounter new people, work hard, and encourage together for youth scouts.

Wishing this experience brings light to your own future.

### **Date and Duration:**

3 - 8 September 2024

Arrival at camp: September 3rd evening

Departure from camp: September 8th afternoon

### **Venue:**

Camp Nasu

7-chome 334 Nishimishima, Nasushiobara City, Tochigi, 329-2756 JAPAN

It is about 200km from the Haneda airport and takes 2 hours and a half by chartered bus.

### **Eligible participants:**

- Scouts and young leaders must be registered members of the National Scout Organization registered to the World Organization of the Scout Movement.
- Overseas participants aged between 18 to 25 years old at the time of the event.

### **Number of participants:**

Each Scout organization can send a maximum of 5 participants to the Moot.

### **Participation fee**

JPY30,000 per person

The fee covers the followings:

- meals on site starting from dinner on 3rd to lunch on the 8th
- transportation between Haneda airport to the campsite
- Programme
- moot souvenirs

**Payment:**

The contingent must complete the payment for all participants together with the submission of individual registration through their National Scout Organization **not later than 30 June 2024.**

**Payment Note:**

**Working Language:**

Since this is a Japanese national event, most of the programs will be held in Japanese, but there will be liaison officers beside and translate it into English.

**Passports and Visa:**

All visitors to Japan **MUST** have a valid passport. Please check whether your passport has a remaining term over **six months**. Otherwise, you will not be allowed to enter the country.

**Time Zone:**

GMT +9

**Transportation**

It is recommended to arrive at the **Haneda Airport**.  
 The bus will come at this time, so please take into consideration bus time when you book a flight.

- 9/3(Tue) Depart from Haneda airport at 11A.M.  
 9/8(Sun) Depart from Nasu training center at 4P.M.

\*It will take about three hours between Haneda airport and Nasu campsite.

**Climate:**

Nasu Shiobara City is located more than 200 meters above sea level and has a cool, plateau-like climate. The average temperature at the beginning of September is about 24°C (82°F). The average daily maximum is about 29°C (84°F) and the average daily minimum is 21°C (70°F). This area has high rainfall.

**Attire and Dress Code:**

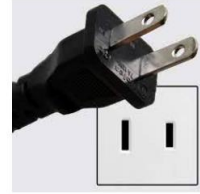
Attire for the Workshop will include Scout Uniform for Opening and Closing Ceremonies and formal functions. Smart casual will be worn in most of the programs.

**Foreign Exchange:**

Currency exchange services are not available around the moot venue, we strongly recommend exchanging currency at the airport. Participants will travel directly from the airport to the Moot venue.

**Electricity:**

Electricity in East Japan is 100V, 50Hz. The electrical socket commonly used in Japan is Type A electrical plug. It is highly recommended to bring your own converter if necessary.



**Food**

Meals will be provided three times a day. Halal friendly meal will be prepared upon prior request at participant registration.

**What to prepare**

  - sleeping bag or blanket
  - sleeping mattress
  - toiletries (towel, soap, shampoo, etc)
  - plates, forks, etc
  - rain gear
  - hat or cap
  - flashlight
  - insect repellent
  - traditional food or snack

- Safe from Harm Certificate
- Other items that you need

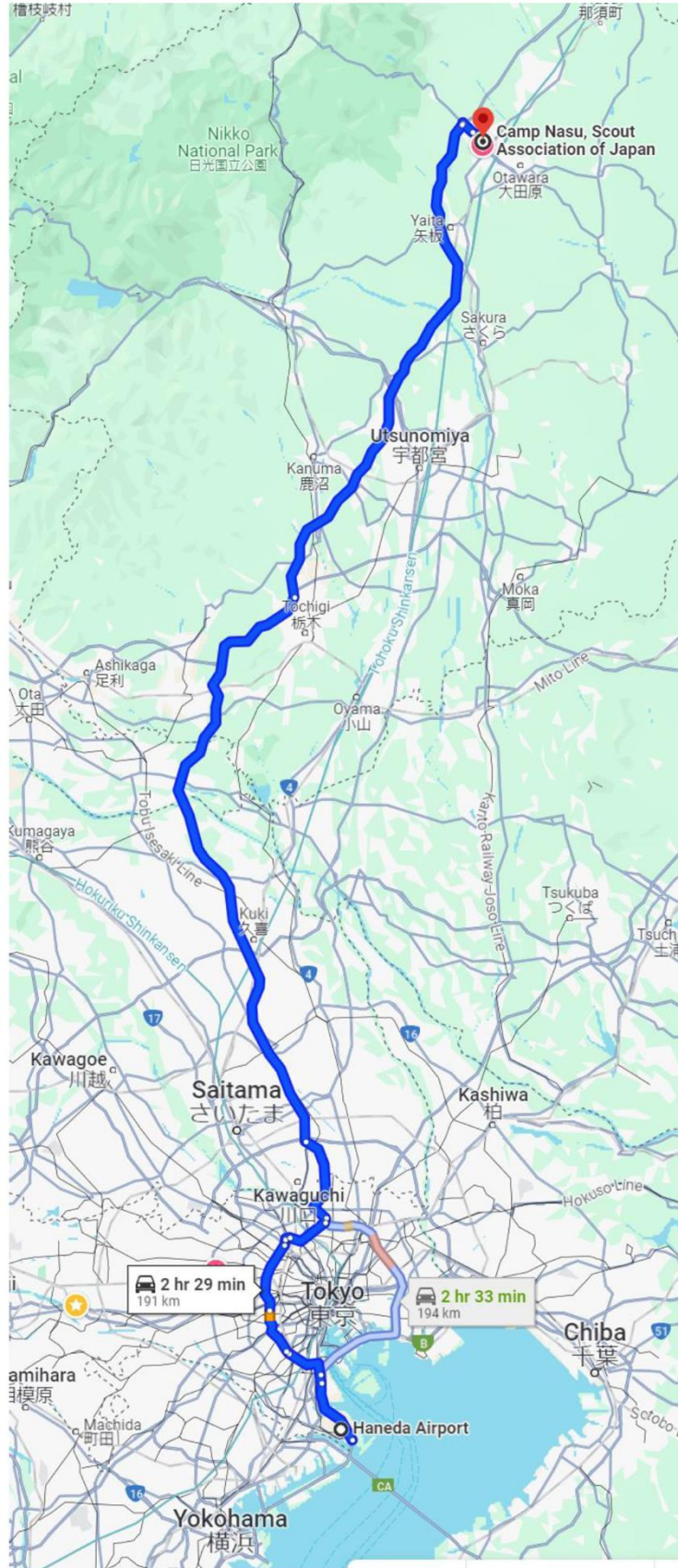
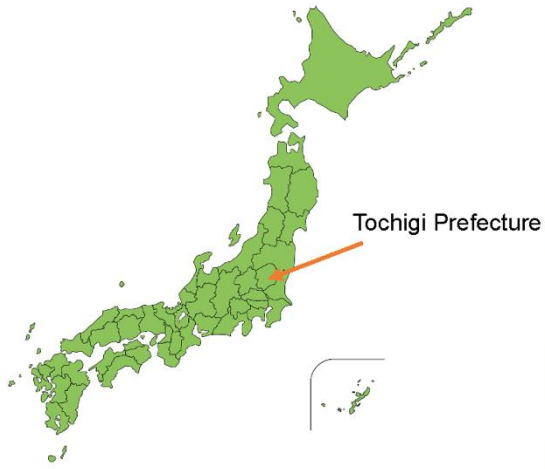
